Good afternoon,

to enter Cuba from Israel you need your passport and the tourist card issued by our Embassy. If you have a Provisional Passport, it must be valid for 6 months or more, otherwise it does not qualify and you will have to present your official passport.

Good afternoon!

My name is Evgenia, and I represent ATLAS. Unfortunately, there is no Cuba embassy in Israel, so we had to contact the nearest embassies to clarify our question. At the moment, at the request of the Israelis, we are updating data on entry to different countries using the Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport. It is a second passport and is issued exclusively to Israeli citizens who do not live in the country. This passport is also known as a Provisional Passport.

According to the visa agreement between Israel and Cuba, Israeli citizens with a Darkon must issue a tourist card, after which they can enter the country. What are the rules of entry into your country for Israeli citizens with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport?

We are looking forward to receiving a response to update the data on entry to Cuba with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport.
