Thank you for your email. Israeli citizens who are using the Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport are permitted to enter Estonia on the same grounds as those who hold the ordinary passport. In other words, they are entitled to the same rights and criteria (90 visa-free days in 180 days period).

At the moment, at the request of the Israelis, we are updating data on entry to different countries using Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport. It is a second passport and is issued exclusively to Israeli citizens who do not live in the country.

According to the visa agreement between Israel and Estonia, Israeli citizens who own a darkon can visit the country without obtaining a visa and stay in it for 90 days. What are the rules of entry into your country for Israeli citizens with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport?

We are looking forward to receiving a response to update the data on entry to Estonia with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport.
