Guten Tag! My name is Evgenia, and I represent ATLAS. At the moment, at the request of the Israelis, we are updating data on entry to different countries using Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport. It is a second passport and is issued exclusively to Israeli citizens who do not live in the country.

According to the visa agreement between Israel and Germany, Israeli citizens who own a Darkon can visit the country without obtaining a visa and stay in it for 90 days. What are the rules of entry into your country for Israeli citizens with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport?
