RE: Clarification of the order of entry of Israeli citizens with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport

In general, a holder of the travel document **in lieu of national passport** for Israeli citizens is not required to obtain a visa prior to his visit to Japan when the purpose of his visit is commercial, attendance at conferences, tourism, visits to relatives/acquaintances, etc. for the duration of 90 days or less.

Exemption of Visa (Short-Term Stay): https://www.mofa.go.jp/j_info/visit/visa/short/novisa.html

If you go to Japan as a short term visitor within the scope of the visa exemption agreement between two countries, the maxim period of stay that could be granted by Japanese Immigration officer after examination at entry ports upon your arrival is up to 90 days.

·Period of Stay

The period of stay granted at the time of the landing permission shall be the shortest period out of "15 days", "30 days" or "90 days," that is long enough to cover the purpose of the stay of the foreign national.

It is recommended that you register on the Visit Japan website before arriving to Japan in order to complete immigration and customs questionnaires. Once you have completed the registration process, the website will generate two QR codes, which you will need to present upon your arrival in Japan.
