Thank you for your e-mail.

Please be informed, that Israeli citizens who are holders of *Travel Document in Lieu of national passport/Provisional passport* of the State of Israel can enter Latvia without obtaining a visa.

According to the Agreement Between The Government Of The Republic Of Latvia And The Government Of The State Of Israel On The Abolition Of Visa Requirements For Holders Of Regular National Passport, Citizens of either Contracting Party, holding valid national passports authorising the crossing of State borders, shall be allowed to enter, leave, transit and stay on the territory of the State of the other Contracting Party without visas, for up to ninety (90) days.

Good afternoon!

My name is Jane, and I represent ATLAS. At the moment, at the request of the Israelis, we are updating data on entry to different countries using Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport. It is a second passport and is issued exclusively to Israeli citizens who do not live in the country. This passport is also known as a Provisional Passport.

According to the visa agreement between Israel and Latvia, Israeli citizens who own a Darkon can visit the country without obtaining a visa and stay in it for 90 days. What are the rules of entry into your country for Israeli citizens with Travel Document in Lieu of National Passport?
